Through the ITTP, MTN will offer free accredited modules with comprehensive telehealth education and training for all health disciplines. Curriculum topics include best practices, technology guidance, legal and regulatory updates, and key considerations on patient safety.

## EVIDENCE-BASED CONTENT AREAS

1	<b>ACCESS &amp; EQUITY</b>	Barriers and motivators to telehealth adoption.
2	<b>TECHNOLOGY</b>	Common patient-owned devices and challenges/considerations when using digital health interventions.
3	<b>COMMUNICATION &amp; SAFETY</b>	Fundamental communication skills in virtual settings and appropriate use of telehealth.
4	<b>ASSESSMENT</b>	History taking, medication reconciliation, patient-generated data, technology limitations, and care escalation.
5	<b>ETHICAL &amp; LEGAL</b>	Informed consent, ethical considerations, professional challenges, conflict of interest.
